When you have a BCP/DR solution, you ensure that your organization will continue operations during a disruptive event with:

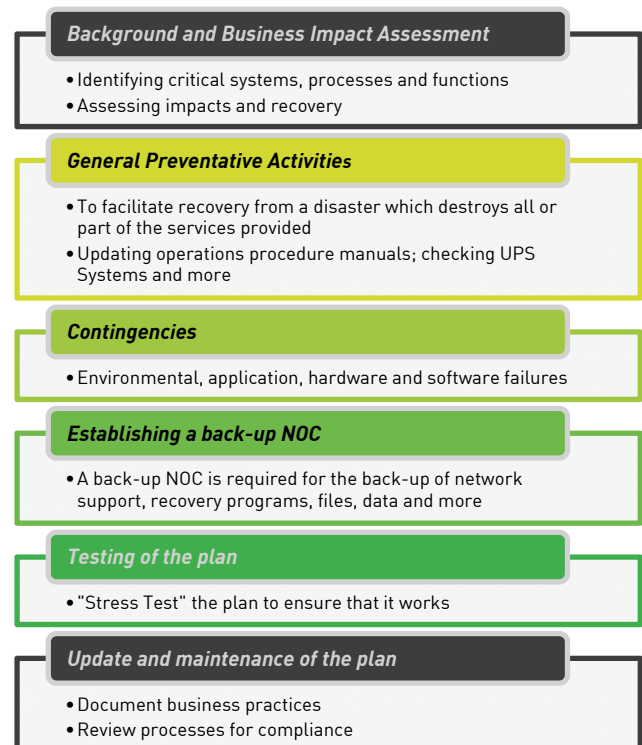
- End-to-End Continuity

WHAT IS BUSINESS CONTINUITY PLANNING?

BCP is coordinated planning between infrastructure (network and IT), facilities management and business processes to facilitate the continuation or resumption of operations in the event of a business disruption. It includes defining procedures for a contingency plan for recovery from disruption and planning for an orderly recovery and resumption of critical operations in the event of a disruption.

The goals of any BCP should be to continue critical business operations no matter what the disruption or situation, minimize any immediate damage or losses, and ensure that recovery happens in a timely manner. BCP should be reviewed annually or after any key process change.

BCP KEY ELEMENTS

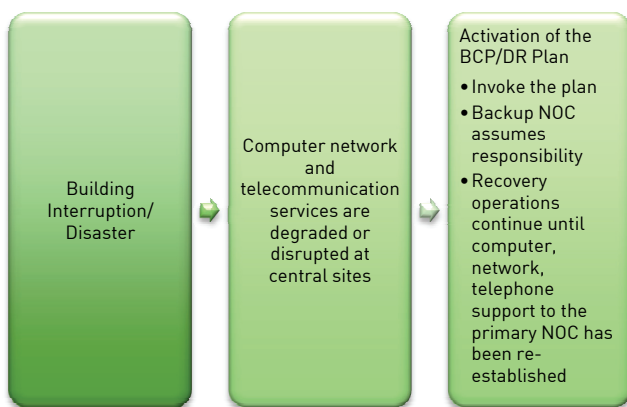


WHAT IS DISASTER RECOVERY?

Disaster Recovery is the action taken to reduce the probability of impact to infrastructure, operations and personal injury in the event of an incident, natural disaster or other disrupting event. It includes implementing a response strategy to prevent or minimize the impact of an event and to resume critical operations.

Disaster Recovery plans should be updated after any process change and should be in place 24x7.
